Executive Summary

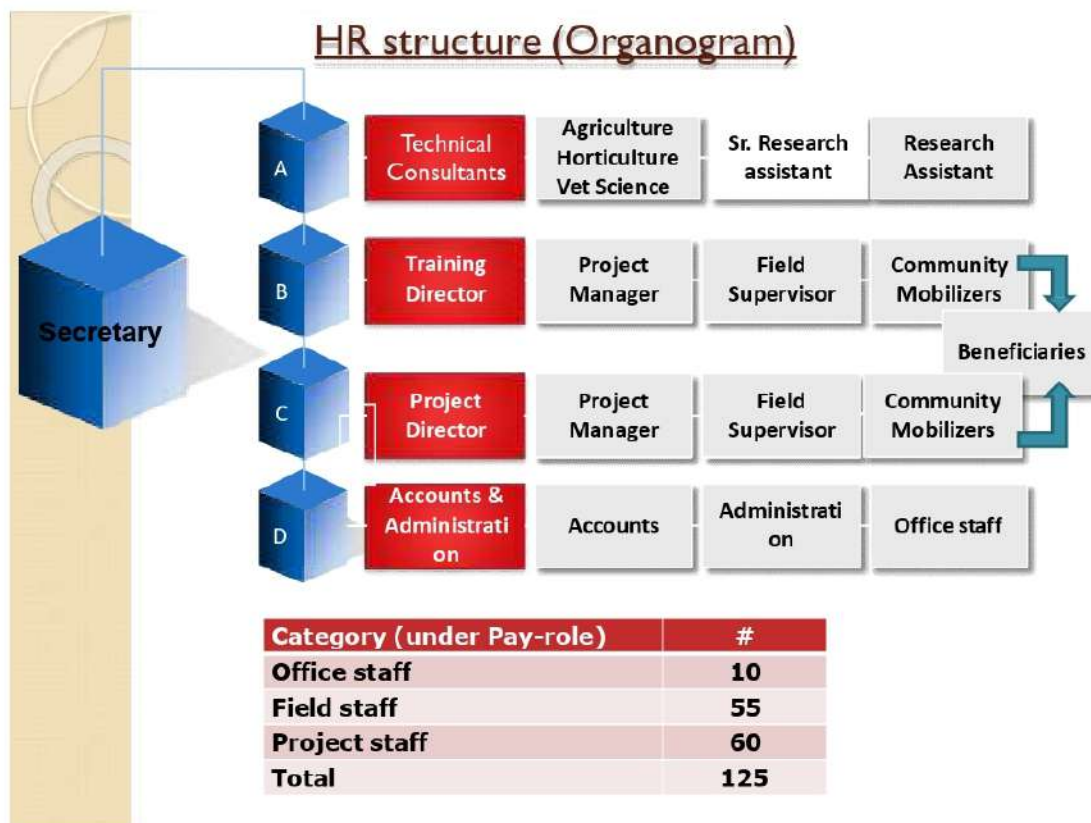

Netaji Subhas Training Institute of Agricultural Marketing, the training institute of West Bengal State marketing Board under Department of Agricultural Marketing, Govt. of West Bengal selected Consortium for Training , Research and Development (CTRD) to facilitate one fully residential skill development training programme exclusively for the young members of the Small and Marginal Farm Families with special thrust upon the SC and ST communities of three districts of West Bengal namely **Bankura -Hirbandh Group-I and Hirbandh Group-II Block, DakshinDinajpur- Balurghat and Kumarganj Block and Nadia-Krishnagar-I and Nabadwip**.
