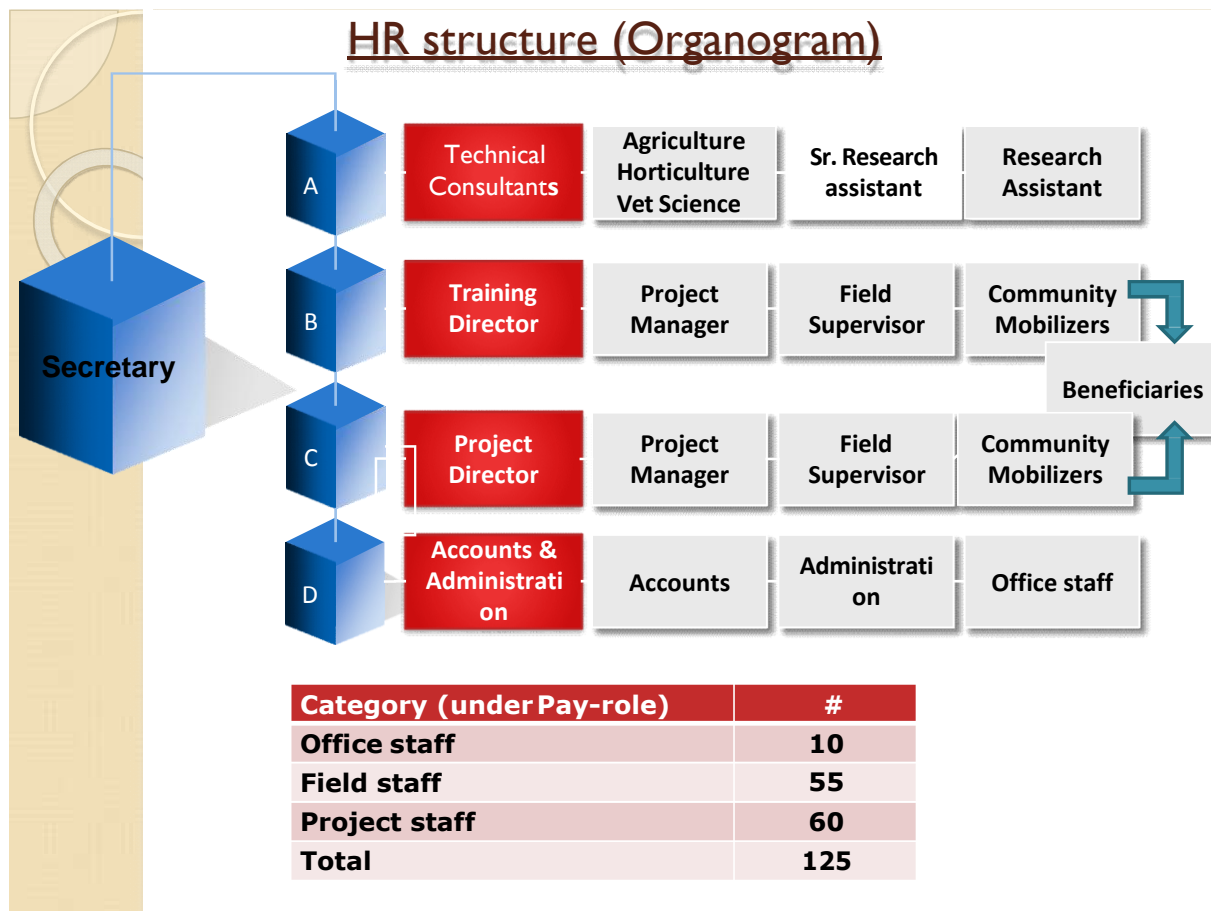

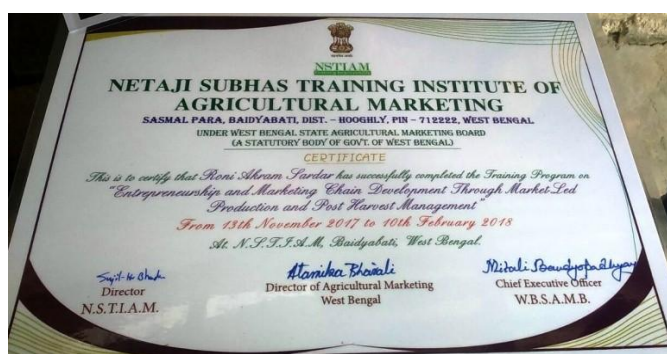

Case Study: Nandakumar and Kolaghat Block Promising Young Farmers of Nandakumar

Nandakumar, a Block under Purba Medinipur District, is a land of pond and betel leaves. Nearly one fifth of its earnings of Nandakumar comes from fisheries. Total 14 young farm family members of Nandakumar received a training on **“Entrepreneurship and Market-Chain Development through Market-Led Production and Post-Harvest Management”** at NSTIAM (Netaji Subhas Training Institute of Agricultural Marketing), a renowned training institute under WBSMB (West Bengal State Agricultural Marketing Board) in the year of 2016-17.

Focussed training at NSTIAM for 13 weeks helped the trainees to prepare a Business development plan (BDP) and understand pros and cons of functioning in groups. Accordingly, they formed an SHG namely **“Sahid Khudiram Krishak Swasahayak Dal”** and submitted a project on **“Fish cultivation”** for subsequent bank linkage. However, insistence from some of the group members to have steady return throughout the year helped the group to perceive an add-on project regarding **marketing of betel leaves**, too. Through these projects, trainees of Nandakumar received a fund of Rupees Two Lakhs only (Rs. 2,00000/-) from the Govt of West Bengal, which was fixed at Allahabad Bank, Sulochona branch to receive an overdraft of Rs Rs.167000.00 during Jan’2017.

During January’17 to **March’2018 (15 months)** the group earned Rs.1, 35,000/- by marketing of fish and Rs.5, 54,200/- through selling betel leaves at the wholesale market of Nandakumar. The group members were procuring betel leaves from nearby villages and marketing it through their groups’ combined effort.

In the month of **March’2018** the **trainees repaid** entire OD amount with interest to Allahabad bank. In the month of April’18 they received an added amount of Rs.2, 14,000.00 from the bank and invested the same for their business. With the help of this added investment they earned Rs.1,50,000/- by selling fish from **April’18 to March’2019** and Rs.5, 50,000/- **through marketing of** betel leaves during the same period.

Before attending the training programme at Baidyabati, all the members used to do cultivation of their own land and earn accordingly. Training at NSTIAM made them to realise the strength of unity and doing business in groups as a risk mitigation strategy and increased bargaining power. This project has helped the young members of the farm families of Nandakumar block to earn **an extra amount of Rs 5000 to 6000/-** throughout the year over their normal income through individual farming. The success in group business has triggered their hope and enhanced the vision of networking to a larger dimension.



Promising Young Farmers of Kolaghat

East Midnapore or Purba Medinipur, is one of the 18 administrative districts of West Bengal with its headquarters located at Tamluk. The district was carved out of the erstwhile Medinipur on January 1, 2002.

Kolaghat, a Block under Purba Medinipur District is known as one of the major flower growing hub of West Bengal. Through a training programme named **“Entrepreneurship and Market-Chain Development through Market-Led Production and Post-Harvest Management”** at NSTIAM (**Netaji Subhas Training Institute of Agricultural Marketing**), under WBSMB (**West Bengal State Agricultural Marketing Board**) eleven number of young farm family members were trained during 2016-17.

Focussed training at NSTIAM for 13 weeks helped the trainees to prepare a Business development plan (BDP) on Floricultural activities. Exposure visits and hands on training at NSTIAM convinced them about doing business in groups. Hence they formed an SHG namely **“Vidyasagar Swanirbhar Gosthi”** and submitted a project on **“Marketing of Flower”** for subsequent bank linkage. During the course of training itself, all the members raised a fund Rs.55,000/- (Rupees Fifty Five thousand only) of their own for starting their business until receiving further support from the Government.

Upon completion of the training programme, trainees’ group received a fund of Rupees Two Lakhs only (Rs. 2,00,000/-) from the Govt of West Bengal, which was fixed at Corporation Bank, Deulia Bazar branch that helped them to receive an overdraft of Rs.1,59,000/- (One Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand Only) in June’2017.

During **January’17 to March’2018 this group earned Rs.3, 93,800/-** (Rupees Three Lakhs Ninety Three Thousand and Eight hundred only) by marketing of flowers at the wholesale market of Kolaghat and Howrah Mallickghat bazar. They were procuring flowers from the field of group members as well as nearby villages and marketing it through their groups’ wholesome effort.

Within **March’2018 the trainees repaid** entire OD amount with an interest to the Corporation bank which enhanced their credit worthiness. Thus they received an amount of Rs.2, 19,000.00 (Rupees Two Lakhs Nineteen Thousand only) from the bank in April’18 again and invested the same for expansion of their business. With the help of this added investment they earned Rs.4,80,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Eighty Thousand only) by **selling flower and subsequent value addition for festive decoration**. This project has helped the young members of the farm families of Kolaghat block to earn **an extra amount of Rs 10,000 to 15,000/- per month** during festive season of the year. The innovative training approach by the Govt. Of West Bengal through WBSMB and NSTIAM has changed the life of the young farm family members who have become example for others.

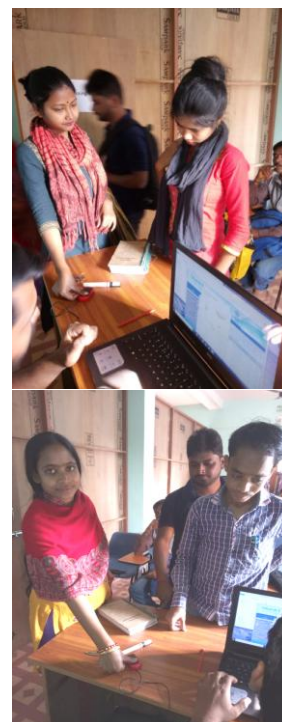
